2012 UW-WMARS Trial Site Weather Conditions

We started the season with a severe deficit in subsoil moisture. We planted out the trials Jun 1 and proceeded to have the driest June ever recorded in Madison (.31in). In conjunction with the lack of rain we had 25 days of clear skies and 9 days above 90 degrees. We encountered a situation where we were forced to irrigate every 6-10 days. This was complicated by the fact that much of the moisture we applied either soaked down deep or was evaporated by the high temps and clear skies. It took nearly 3 weeks of irrigation to get an adequate amount of moisture built up into the root zone of the plants.

The rest of the growing season continued to be dry and hot. From Jun 1- Sept 30 we had 36 days over 90 degrees with a high of 104; 95 clear sunny days; and a total of 7.22in of rain.
