at Wisconsin Agricultural Research Stations

Both seeded and seedless table grapes have outstanding potential to be developed for fresh market and processing (i.e. raisins) in the state of Wisconsin. Both the West Madison Peninsular Agricultural (WMARS) and Research Stations (PARS) have table grapes on display to test for cold and drought tolerance, fruit production, and unique flavor and fruit characteristics. A part of this program involves outreach through vineyard walks, talks, taste tests, and exploring raisin production.
