- jalapenos were earliest to produce and produced very high yields through the end of July before their yields began to decrease, they were very beautiful and tasty peppers.
- Flaming Flare and Hot Sunset were VERY hot peppers. Hot sunset was one of the later peppers to produce, began in late July/ Early August
- Mad Hatter was one of the latest to start ripening, couldn't harvest until early august. Crisp and delicious and worth the wait!
